## HEPATITIS C



Hepatitis C  
HAS A CURE!



If you use/inject drugs  
you can still be treated  
for Hepatitis C.



Hepatitis C is passed by  
**blood-to-blood contact**  
(e.g., sharing drug use equipment or  
water; sharing tattoo equipment,  
rough sex when blood is present).



The only way to know if  
you currently have  
hepatitis C is by getting a  
hepatitis C virus test.

## HIV



HIV can live in these body fluids:

**Blood, sex fluids** (cum, pre-cum, vaginal fluid, rectal fluid), **breast milk**.

HIV can also be passed when a parent gives birth if they are not taking their HIV meds.

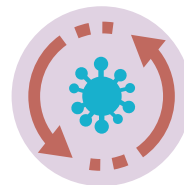


When people living with HIV **take their HIV meds every day**,  
HIV will usually be **undetectable in their blood**. This means  
they CANNOT pass HIV to others during sex. This is called U=U  
(undetectable = untransmittable).

## STBBIs



The **only way to know for  
sure if you have an STI  
(sexually transmitted  
infection) is to GET TESTED!**



People **cured of hepatitis C  
or other curable STBBIs,**  
can get **re-infected!**
